10th ANNUAL CAR SHOW TO BE HELD TO BENEFIT “JERRY’S KIDS” IN CENTRAL VIRGINIA

Richmond, VA, June 23, 2009 - August 8, 2009 will mark the 10th anniversary of a car show held to benefit the Central Virginia Muscular Dystrophy Association at Richard Bland College in Petersburg.

Wayne Balch has served as the event chairman all ten years of the event, which has raised over \$202,000 in total, including a record \$28,700 in 2008. Mr. Balch attributes the success of the event to generous car clubs and enthusiasts who have supported the event and MDA for years. “This years car show will be a celebration of 10 years that sponsors of the show and friends of Jerry’s Kids have come together to help our community. We are very excited about this years show,” says Mr. Balch. It will include over 100 awards to be given to participants registering their beautiful vehicles. Strosnider Chevrolet of Hopewell has donated a Chevrolet 350 Crate Engine that will be raffled with the drawing at the show and Hardee’s Restaurant will once again be providing great food. Vendor spaces are available as well.

Proceeds from the car show go directly toward lifesaving programs for people living with neuromuscular diseases in the Central Virginia area. MDA is a voluntary health agency working to defeat 43 neuromuscular diseases through worldwide research,

comprehensive services and far-reaching professional health education. Some of these services in the local area include clinics at UVA, Kluge Children's Rehabilitation Center, MCV and Children's Hospital; local support groups; durable medical equipment; and a summer camp for children with muscle-wasting diseases.

A new addition to this year's event is a children's judging category, provided by Dyeco Insurance Services, Inc. with the help of Hagerty Insurance. The 15 child Judges (ages 8-12) and 15 vehicle owners that will approve their cars being part of this judging will need to pre-register. These 15 children will receive a t-shirt, a judge's badge and cap and will judge one of five categories – paint, under-hood, details, interior and horn sound.
